

### General Information

This new and highly-innovative 4-year honours degree programme will prepare graduates to function professionally through the medium of Irish in a wide variety of chosen career paths.

As well as being highly skilled in the Irish language itself, graduates will also acquire a comprehensive range of experience and knowledge through the medium of Irish in a broad spectrum of subject areas.

The academic diversity offered will provide graduates with opportunities in many administrative, community-based, creative arts and language facilitation contexts, as well as in the established Irish-language professions such as teaching and the public service.

Graduates will also be in a strong position to succeed in the many newly emerging Irish-language contexts within the broader community which have been generated by recent government initiatives.

### Key characteristics of the programme include:

- An immersion approach whereby all modules, including those not directly related to the language itself, will be taught exclusively through the medium of Irish.
- A semester in Year 3 on work placement in the Gaeltacht and/or with an Irish-language organisation.
- Students will develop a deep appreciation and awareness of the central role of the Irish language in contemporary society.
