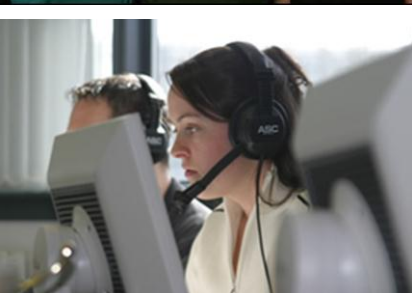

Who are we?

We are an all-Irish Institute, operating under the auspices of the National University of Ireland, Galway and we have responsibility for developing and delivering Irish courses and Irish-medium academic programmes.

Our location

We are located in An Cheathrú Rua in the heart of the Conamara Gaeltacht. Irish is the day to day language of the area and this enables our participants to maximise their contact with the language and to consolidate what is formally learnt in the classroom in an Irish-speaking environment.



These courses are suitable for:

- (a) People who have studied Irish at school but have not used it in recent years and learners who have studied Irish intensively for some years.
- (b) People who are comfortable speaking the language but who wish to extend their vocabulary and add to their knowledge of grammar.
- (c) People who are fluent in Irish but who wish to enrich their spoken vocabulary and focus on more complex aspects of grammar.

Course objectives

- To give students an insight into the diversity of the Irish language through its language, heritage and culture.
- To give students an understanding of the structure and grammar of the language.
- To provide opportunities for students in a vibrant Gaeltacht area that will help them both personally and academically, to learn Irish, to become more fluent in Irish or to immerse themselves totally in the Irish language.



Teaching Approach

The communicative approach to language teaching is used in the classroom and the emphasis is on the learners and their language needs. There is a strong emphasis on group and pair-work, on role-play and language games. Grammar is taught in context, as it is required.
