

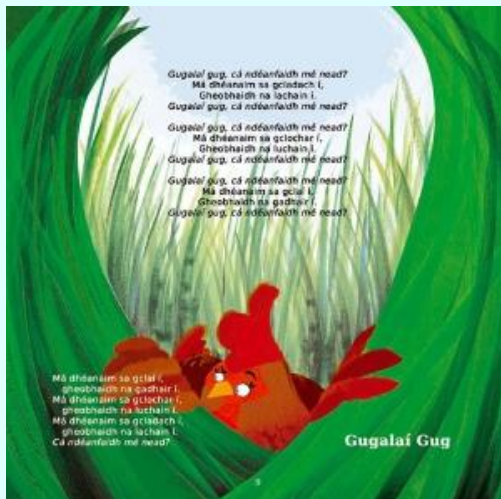


Nuachtlitir Meán Fómhair 2014

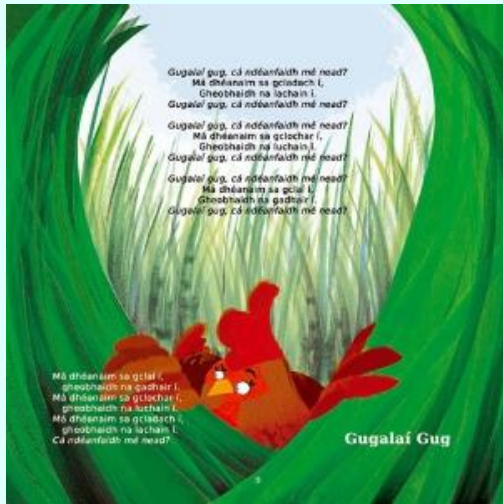
Ábhar Tacaíochta

We are proud to present not one, not two, but three, yes **THREE** new picture books this Autumn. We have an adventurous mix of hungry goats, musical mice and magician monsters! The much loved duo Patricia Forde and Steve Simpson have united again following the success of *Mise agus an Dragún*, to bring you another exciting tale about a lovable little monster who has been warned; Don't wake the baby! *Ná Dúisigh an Páiste!* is the fourth Futa Fata book each from this talented pair. We are delighted to present emerging writers Máire Ní Chualáin and her heart-stopping story about a goat who has a massive appetite, Natasha Rimmington illustrated, **An Gabhar a Raibh An-Ocras go Deo Air** is due in shops shortly as is *Luán agus an Mórfhianó* about a little mouse with a love of music from established television writer but first time published author, Gemma Breathnach, with beautiful illustrations from Delphine Bodet. 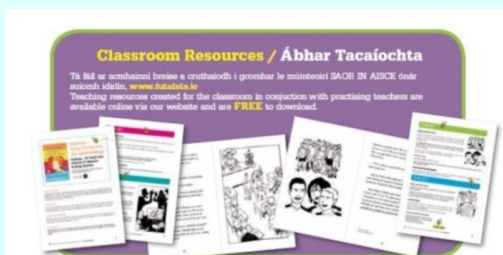
Fun in the Library!
