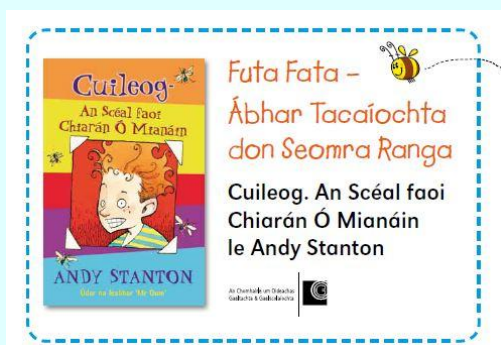




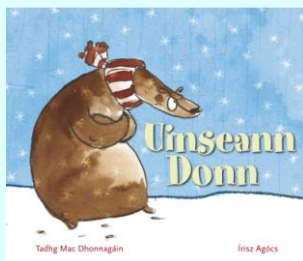

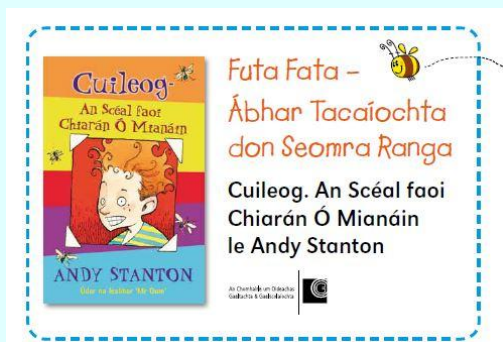


Lá na nAithreacha.

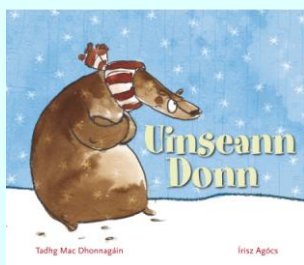

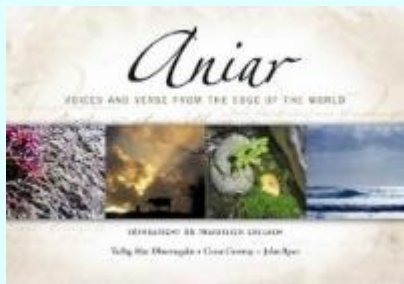
Reading Resources for the Classroom
